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
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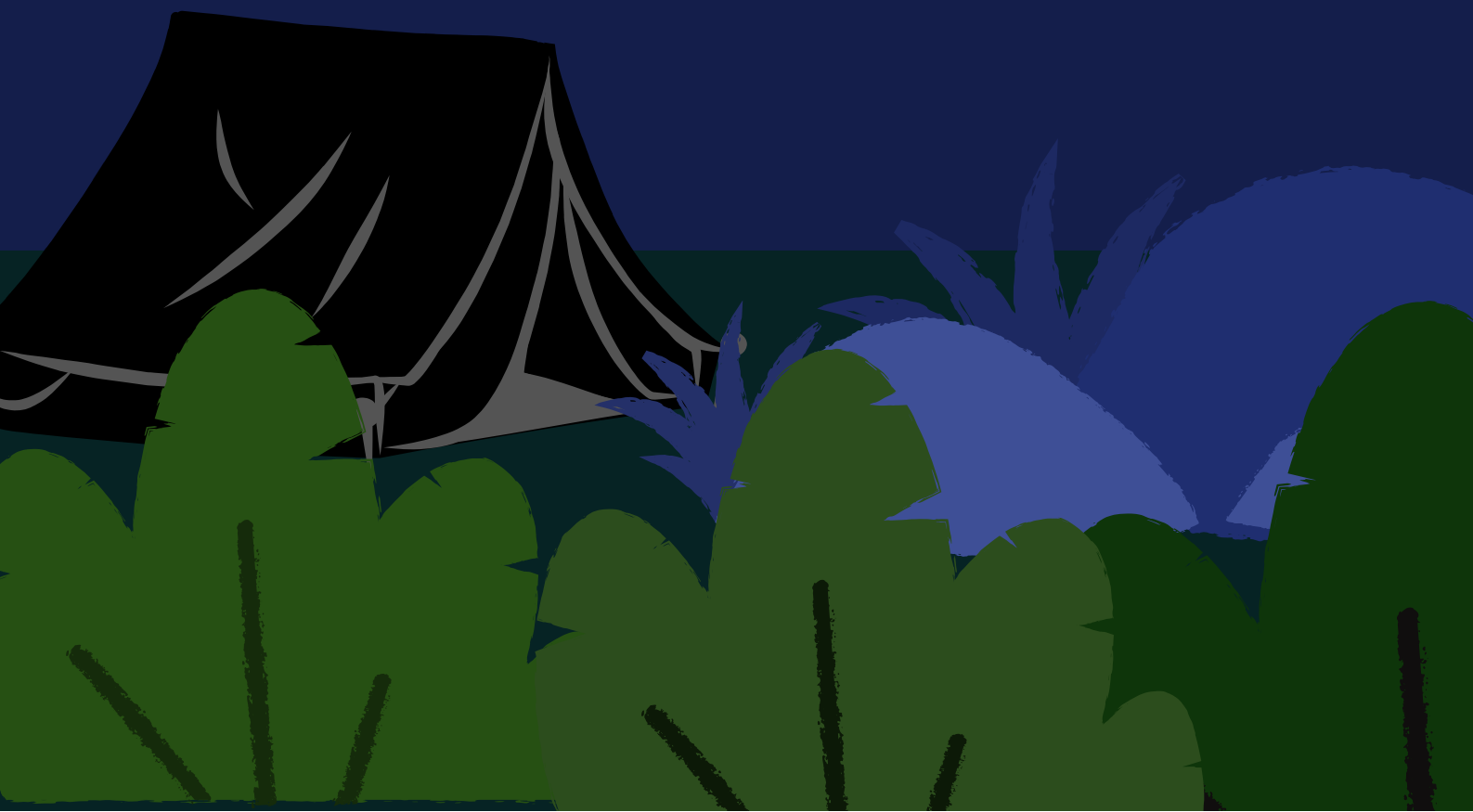

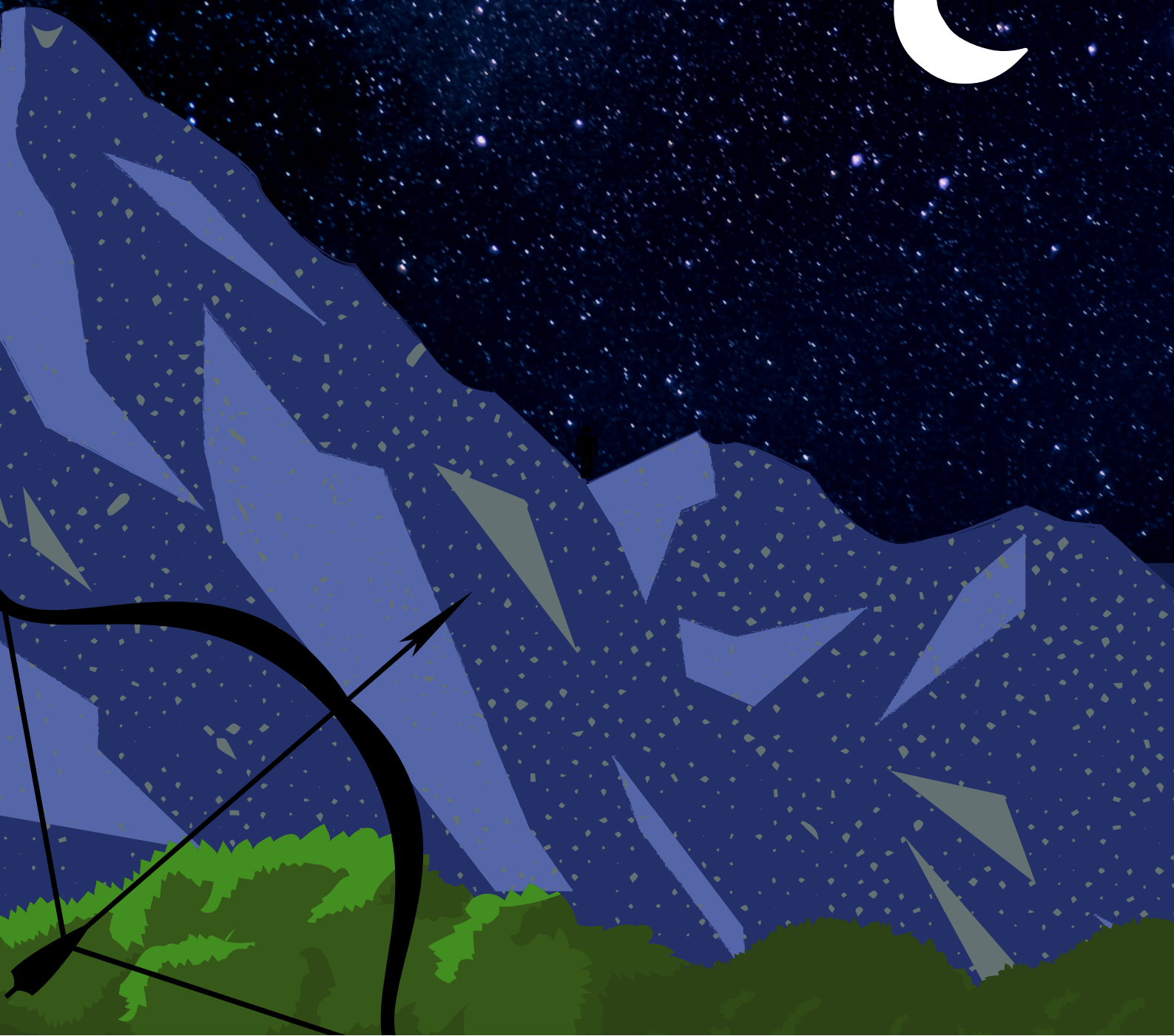

When he inquired why he didn't call him before, he answered he was reciting "Surah Kahf" in his Salat and his heart desired to finish the Surah then wake him up. This was the devotion of Sahaba Ikram (Ridiyallahu Anhu) towards Salat. My little heart lets pray 5 times Salah with devotion.



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
