

The people of that place were fire worshipers. Salman's father was the watchman of the tample. But Salman was very different from his nation, he would search inside his heart, who is my true Lord?












But after staying somedays he found him dishonest, the bishop used to persuade people to give charity and whatever he collected, he used to keep them in his treasure.
