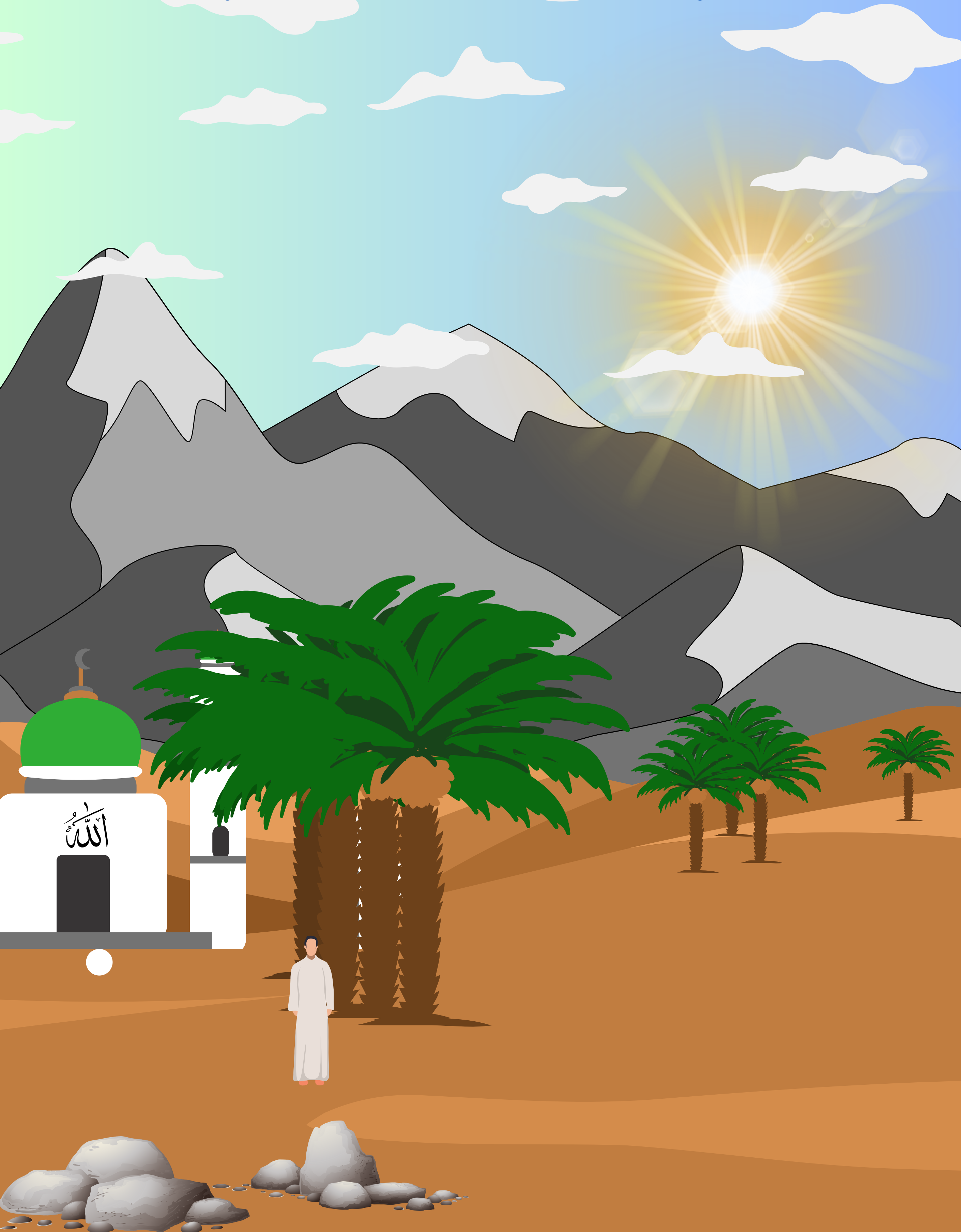

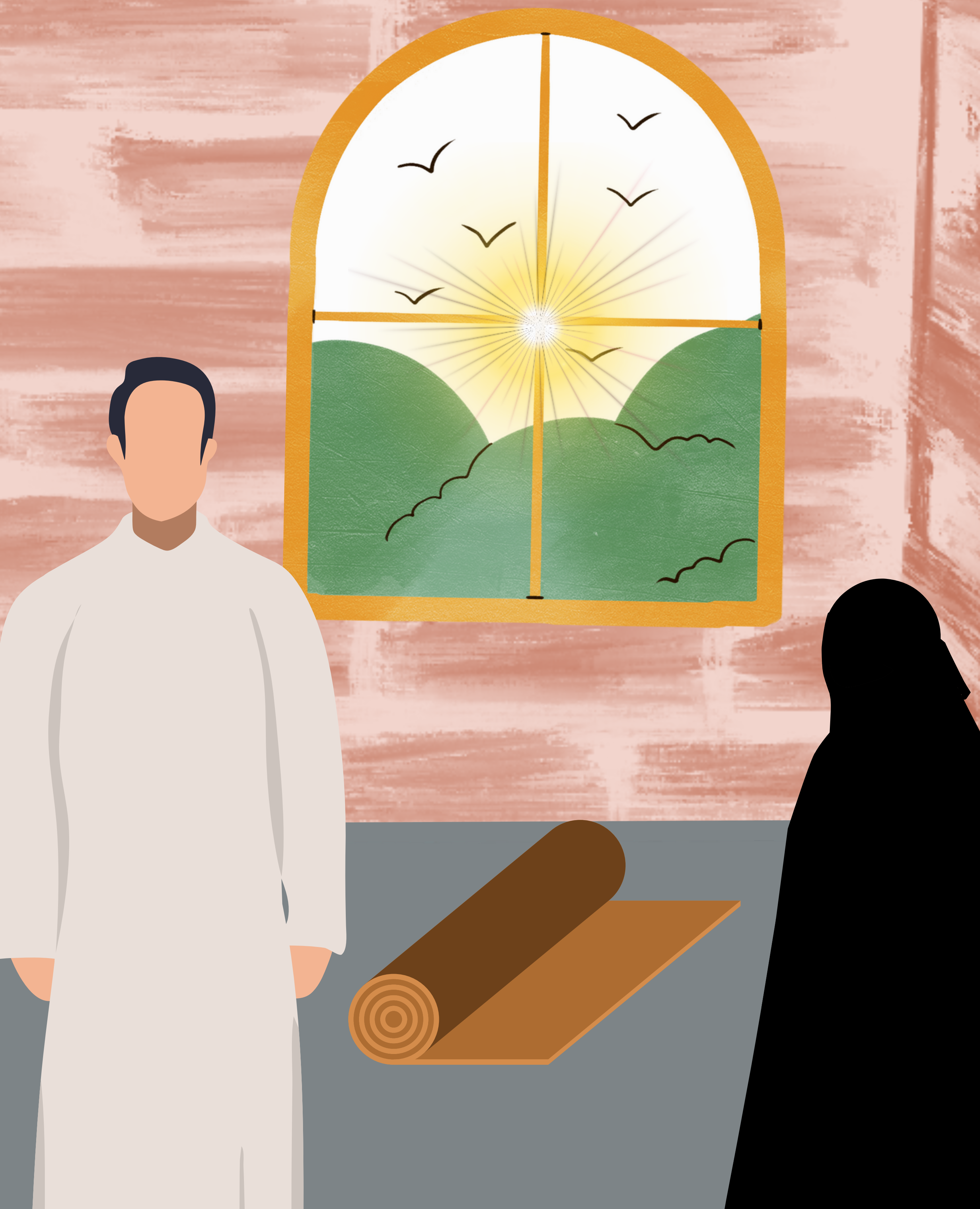

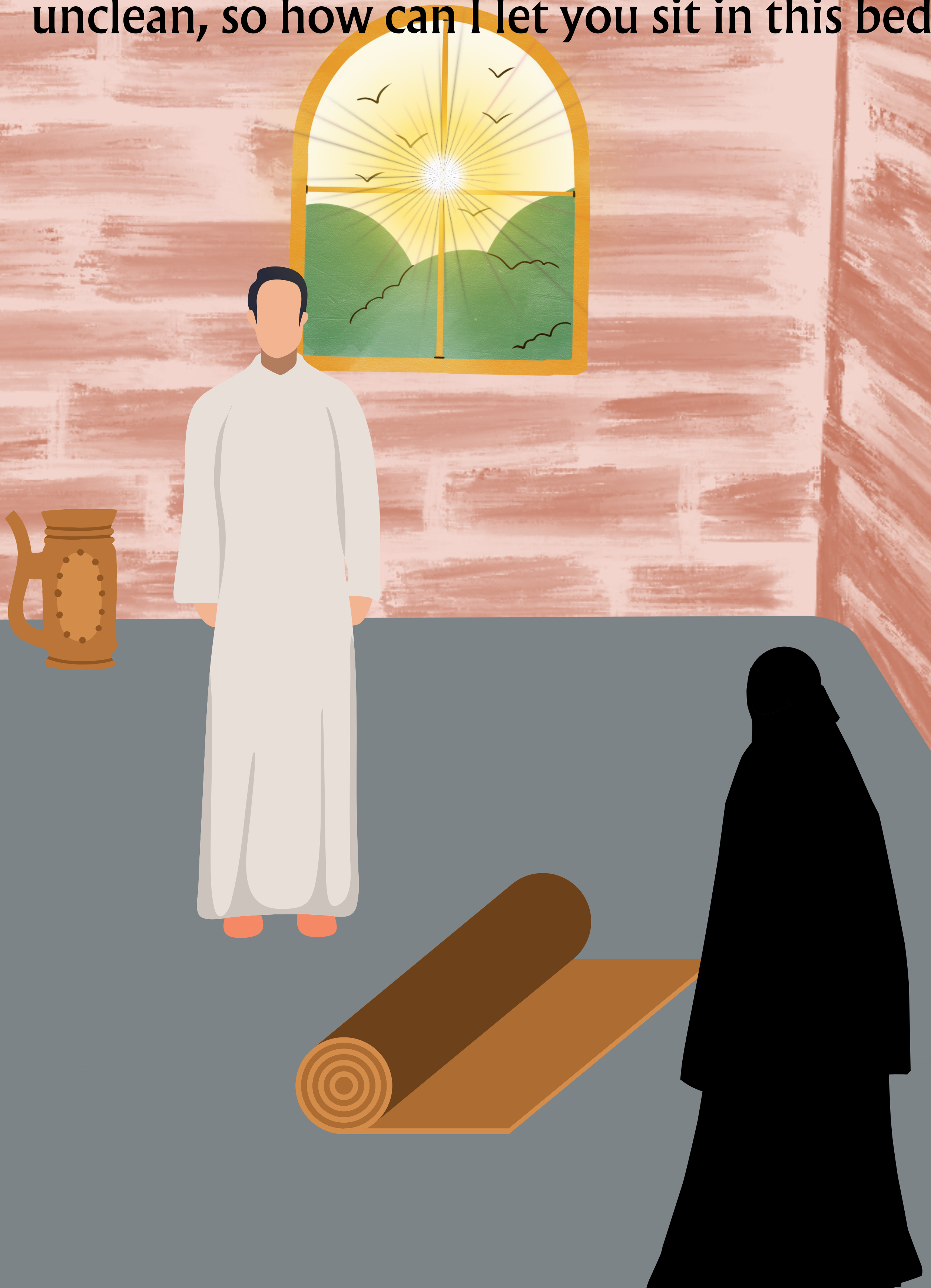

He asked her out of surprise, "Was this bed unfit for me or am I unfit for this bed?" She answered, "This bedding is only for the dear and holy Prophet (Sallallahu Alaihi wa Sallam), and since you are an idolator you are therefore unclean, so how can I let you sit in this bed?"
